Instructions:

Beginning today, develop a list of online resources for teachers in your field. If you are a kindergarten teacher, your online resources will focus on kindergarteners (ages 4 and 5) in all areas of learning (shapes, numbers, reading, writing, etc.). If you are a high school math teacher, your online resources will focus on math, math concepts, and teaching math to students in grades 9 through 12. Your list will grow as you find websites each day or week, and I will provide websites as I find them. I have also included two documents in your course materials, *Websites for Teachers* and *Educational Videos for Teachers*, which will provide many resources for teachers of all disciplines. You may visit those websites, choose the ones that are applicable to your discipline, and add them to your list.

You must include a minimum of ten types of resources and a minimum of four web addresses for each type. (If you collected the minimum number of resources, you would have 40 entries.) Your list may be handwritten, but it must be neat, organized, and legible. (A form is provided with this assignment.) You will actually use this resource list to prepare for other education classes and in your teaching as well as for a PowerPoint slideshow you will develop later this semester. After you complete the resource list, write a two paragraph reflection on what you learned from this assignment.

You will submit your *List of Online Resources* assignment, including the reflection, on a date and time to be announced. I will spot check the resources to be sure they are working sites.
