

Solid of Revolution (Disk/Washer) Study Group Activity

(Groups of 3 or 4 people)

Purpose of activity: Gain a deeper understanding of the topic by solving a problem on your own and then teaching it to your peers.

Due Date: Wednesday November 29th

Individual Portion: Everybody in the group should choose ONE of the problems below. Solve your problem on your own before you meet with your group.

For each problem, set up an integral using a disk or washer to find the volume of the solid of revolution.

1. The region bounded by $y = \frac{1}{2}x^3$; $y = 4$; $x = 0$ around the line $y = 4$
2. The region bounded by $y = \frac{1}{2}x^3$; $y = 4$; $x = 0$ around the line $y = 5$
3. The region bounded by $y = \frac{1}{2}x^3$; $y = 4$; $x = 0$ around the line $x = 2$
4. The region bounded by $y = \frac{1}{2}x^3$; $y = 4$; $x = 0$ around the line $x = 3$
